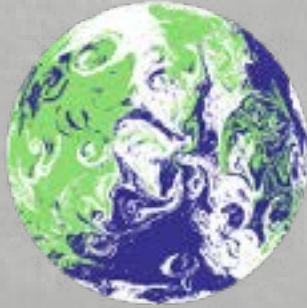


Call for Submissions: Special Environmental Issue

The 26th United Nations Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP26), is set to be held in Glasgow, Scotland, from November 1st to November 12th. ICMPhotoMag is committed to bringing awareness to the environmental issues we all face as a global community and to being proactive in finding ways to effect change. As such, we are planning a Special Environmental Issue of the magazine to coincide with COP26. Annual subscribers will receive this Special Environmental Issue for free as a bonus in their subscription. Non-subscribers will be able to purchase it as a single issue in November.

This Special Environmental Issue will be published on November 1st, and we are now accepting content for the issue with this Call for Submissions.

The intention for this Special Environmental Issue is to show proactive evidence that change is possible. This change can come in a number of different ways, such as through growing vegetables at home, green electricity, energy efficiency, renewables, electric cars, recycling, rewilding, and much more.

We are looking for submissions that really engage with these concepts and that have a clear message centered on environmental themes and issues that will provoke serious thought and change.

Types of Content Acceptable for this Special Environmental Issue:

- A series of ICM images, or a combination of ICM images and traditional 'straight' images, related to an environmental theme, issue, or concept
- Video content which includes ICM imagery and a storyline related to an environmental theme, issue, or concept
- ICM images in combination with environment-focused poetry or prose
- A presentation that communicates your idea or concept about the environment and includes ICM images
- Drawings that may have been inspired by your ICM work related to an environmental theme, issue, or concept

You might choose to respond to how world leaders have handled environmental issues and climate change, or react to an environmental issue in your local area. You might also choose to develop a series of images and an article around the idea of shooting locally, to minimize your impact on travel and carbon emissions. Or, you might choose to create a body of work around a species of plant or animal that has been negatively affected by climate change. However you feel moved to express concern for the environment or to bring awareness to the issues is valid, so don't restrict or limit your thinking and approach to this topic.
